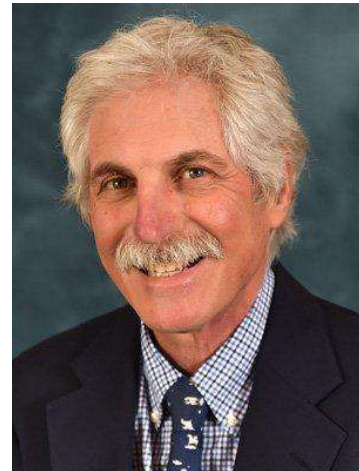







David S. Eingorn, M.D.
